Museum Naming Opportunities

The Sitka Historical Society is now accepting offers from prospective major donors who wish to give significant contributions to fund exhibit design and construction in the new Sitka History Museum and have their names affixed to one of Sitka's most visited buildings.

Not often do benefactors get such meaningful opportunities to see their names on an inspiring cultural building and, by doing so, achieve long lasting public recognition of their generosity and community spirit (*Major donors will retain naming rights for a minimum of twenty (20) years with more years negotiable*).

Your gift will be celebrated at The Sitka History Museum's formal grand opening and naming ceremony in 2017.

The Sitka History Museum Naming Program includes prominently displayed naming opportunities in the areas listed:

\$150,000 and above

- ***Permanent Exhibit Gallery*** (Museum space which houses professionally designed permanent exhibition)
- ***Rotating Exhibit Gallery*** (Museum space which houses two (2) new exhibits each year)

\$75,000 and above

- ***One Permanent Exhibit*** (One display only within the permanent exhibit will be set aside for sponsorship. Donor can choose from following exhibits):
 - ***Hologram Tour*** (Holograms which lead tours of museum), ***Sesquicentennial Exhibit*** (Exhibit which highlights The 150th Anniversary of the Transfer of Alaska), ***Alaska Native History Exhibit*** (Exhibit that recognizes the First People to inhabit our lands), ***Russian American Exhibit*** (Exhibit which tells of early explorers and colonists)
- ***Research/Archives Room*** (823 sq ft public access research area and collections storage)
